By the time you read this, performer and songwriting contest applications should be available at the websites 3RFS.org and Tumbleweedfest.com. Spread the word! Food and craft ven-

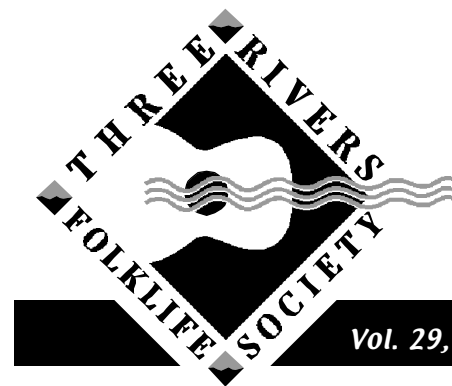

## Fancy That! in Concert

Saturday, 20 January, 7:30PM

Fancy That! Is a duo composed of two of Spokane's favorite folk performers, Jackie Fox and Brad Keeler. Both perform in the band Jackie Fox and the Hounds which is primarily a bluegrass band fronted by Jackie, but as a duo they mostly perform original, traditional and cover songs. Both are accomplished songwriters. Their performances glow with a feeling of home as they explore multiple musical genres rooted in tradition and inspiration. Jackie McIntyre Fox and Brad Keeler have been working together for over 10 years. In addition to their work in the "Fox and Hounds" group the two of them started a "duo" called Fancy That!

Brad Keeler is an award-winning multi-instrumentalist, vocalist, sog-

writer, composer and interpreter of vintage music. He can be seen and heard at the Inland Northwest's premier cultural events - including our own Tumbleweed Music Festival.

Jackie McIntyre Fox has been writing songs since 2005. Her song-crafting lanes to country, folk and Bluegrass. She loves to perform, engage with her audience and share her inspiration with others. Her song "Bluegrass in Bellevue" won 3rd place in the Wintergrass songwriting contest. She has also performed her music at Nashville's Bluebird Cafe's open songwriter venue.

Jami Cooper is a Richland singer-songwriter who has been writing and performing locally for most of her young life. Borrowing from blues, folk, jazz, country and rock, she often weaves Christian themes into her songs, such as "Honest Scales":

Weigh my heart on honest scales  
 Know my integrity  
 And when my heart within me fails  
 Lead me to the Rock that is higher than me

Other songs, like "Snake Bit," evoke a strong local feel:

I been snake-bit  
 I been hard-hit  
 And this desert weather  
 Never calls for rain

You said the rebels dwell  
 In a dry land  
 I been sifting sand  
 Ever since that day

The evening will start with an open mic. Come early to sign up if you want to perform at open mic, because
